NOTES:

1. CCS operating funds are generated from tuition, membership fees, and donations. Fees are set annually by the Board of Directors and presented at the annual Spring Membership meeting.
2. CCS is a registered charitable organization, issuing tax receipts for qualifying donations. When optional reductions that are being offered are not taken, the charitable donation receipt will usually increase by that amount. For tuition payments there is an amount that needs to be covered for the "Cost of Education" per student before the remaining payment is considered a donation.

Example: If a fund raising and volunteer reduction is not taken, the amount paid for tuition is higher. Therefore the amount of the charitable donation receipt will also be higher, in virtually every case, by the amount of the forgone reduction. The charitable tax credit is non-refundable and can be used to reduce your income tax for the applicable tax year. You can find a "Charitable donation tax credit calculator" to assist you in estimating your personal benefit. It is on the Canada Revenue Agency website www.cra.gc.ca, search for "Giving to charity: Information for donors".

3. **Registration Fee** - A registration fee of \$500.00 is required for a child/children attending CCS for the first time, and is payable before the first child is enrolled unless otherwise arranged with the Finance Committee. This fee must accompany the Student Admission Application Form (512), and will be deposited when received. \$100.00 is non refundable. Any of the following may be deducted from the registration fee:
 - CCS membership fees for the previous 3 years.
 - Unspecified general donations to CCS for the previous 3 years.
 - Tuition paid to an OACS or CSI affiliated school for the previous 3 years.
4. **Pre-authorized payment (preferred) or Post-dated cheques are required. Cheques are payable to Calvin Christian School and sent to the school office, attention Finance Manager, by due date.**
5. **Tuition Assistance Fund** - Tuition assistance may be available to some families who are financially unable to pay the full tuition fee. To apply for assistance, please contact our Finance Manager. **Tuition assistance application forms must be completed and returned to the Finance Manager by mid June for consideration by the Finance Committee.**
6. **Donations to the Tuition Assistance Fund** - Families who are financially able are encouraged to contribute to the tuition assistance fund to assist those who are unable to meet the total tuition amount. Such "arms length" donations meet the definition of a charitable donation and will be handled accordingly. Also see Note 2 above.
