



A NOTE TO PARENTS AND STUDENTS

_____ is arranging a trip for students to go to Snow Valley Resort to ski/snowboard/blade/tube/snowshoe. This signed form is required for all students who wish to participate in this outdoor recreation and snow sport education program. It should be understood that the purpose of this excursion is educational. Lessons are mandatory.

INHERENT RISK

Skiing/Snowboarding/Blading/Tubing/Snowshoeing is a sport with physical demands and inherent risks which are beyond the control of Snow Valley Resort and _____ School Board. Falls, collisions and other incidents may occur which result in serious injury or death. Participants **must assume** the inherent risks of the sport.

Following all rules and procedures can reduce the risk of injury. Failure to follow the rules will result in the student losing their lift ticket and future resort privileges.

EQUIPMENT

Snow Valley Resort provides rental equipment. Bindings on ski equipment reduce the risk of injury when falling. They will not release under all circumstances and they do not guarantee safety in all cases. Snowboard, Snowblade and Snowshoe bindings do not release. All school group participants are required to wear a helmet. Helmets may reduce the risk of injury when falling. Parents must accept responsibility for equipment that is lost or damaged (other than reasonable wear and tear)

ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE

The Ontario Snow Resort Association has produced a Responsibility Code which Snow Valley Resort and _____ School Board requires that you know and obey. Skiers, Snowboarders and Snowbladers always must be in control and be able to stop and change direction to avoid collisions with other people or objects. Snow Valley Resort may revoke a lift ticket for violation of the code or other unacceptable conduct.

Skill Classification

Non: has never skied/boarded/bladed before.

Beginner: the student has skied/boarded/bladed once or twice or a few times per year and has experienced and maintained control on a number of novice hills of varying difficulty. He/She is able to stop and turn with some success.

Intermediate: The student has skied/boarded/bladed on many occasions and has experienced a variety of hills and different ski areas. He/she can turn and stop under control using recognized formal techniques.

Advanced: The student is an experienced and competent skier/boarder/blader. He/she has received formal instruction, knows and understands the Responsibility Code and can demonstrate ability at an advanced level. Such students can be called upon to assist supervisors.
